The husband-wife team of Kenneth and Betty had an awesome game on Monday, May 21, despite a bad beginning, proving that one low board or two does not an afternoon ruin.

On the very first board, board number one at table number one against team number one, Kenneth opened four hearts, showing a very long heart suit. Usually when a player makes this bid, he almost has the contract made in his own hand. Ninety nine times

out of one hundred, partner will pass. Not this time, however.

Partner Betty had 21 high card points. After pondering long and hard, she bid seven hearts. South doubled the contract and proceeded to lead the ace of trumps. Now, there are lots of cards declarer might be missing and still make seven, but the ace of trumps is not one of them. The Wilkins went down one doubled, while most other teams bid and made six hearts or six no trump.

When Kenneth asked, “Why didn't you ask for aces?” Mrs. Wilkins responded, “Well, I felt sure you had the ace of trumps. I had the other three.”

Despite an inauspicious beginning, the twosome went on to victory with an awesome 65% game. What a crazy game bridge is. Nobody can ever conquer it, and that's why players keep coming back week after week.

Raleigh Bridge Club
